General Membership Meetings are held each Thursday morning at 7:00 a.m. Hybrid Meetings in person and by Zoom by email invitation. 3rd Thursday of each month our meeting is at Noon. In Person at the Ellsworth County Medical Center, 1604 Aylward Ave, Ellsworth, KS. Meetings last approximately one hour. An optional breakfast, including coffee, is available for a charge of \$5.00, billed to you by the treasurer and payable monthly. Coffee only is free.

Members are assessed dues for the fiscal year October 1 to September 30. These dues can be paid monthly or annually. Nearly all of the dues collected are passed on to the State, National and International levels of Kiwanis. Dues are \$12 per month or \$144 per year. All dues for the year must be paid in full by September 30 of each year or your membership will be in jeopardy. We have an automatic charge of \$12 twice per year to cover club administrative expenses, called our "No-Bake" Sale. The new member fee is \$100 and can be paid in installments. We have both individual and corporate memberships available.
