General Membership Meetings are held 2nd & 4th Thursdays at 11:30 a.m. Hybrid Meetings in person and by Zoom by email invitation. In Person at the Ellsworth County Medical Center, 1604 Aylward Ave, Ellsworth, KS. Meetings last approximately one hour. An optional lunch is available for a charge of \$5.00, billed to you by the treasurer and payable monthly. Coffee/tea are free.

Members are assessed dues for the fiscal year October 1 to September 30. These dues can be paid monthly or annually. The majority of the dues collected are passed on to the State and International levels of Kiwanis. Effective 10-1-24, dues are \$17 per month or \$204 per year. All dues for the year must be paid in full by September 30 of each year or your membership will be in jeopardy. The new member fee is \$100 and can be paid in installments. We have both individual and corporate memberships available.
